

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE ASSOCIATION

1. The Association shall supply a continuous supply of safe drinking water to its current users.
2. The Association shall also provide a water line blowing program to all homeowners, the cost of which will be included in the yearly Association Community Service Fees. All Homeowners are prohibited from blowing their own water lines while connected and open to the Association Water System. If any Homeowner insists on blowing their own house lines, the Water System Manager must be notified and he will shut-off the water at the stopbox, the Homeowner then can do what they wish. After the Homeowner is finished, the Water System Manager will re-access the Homeowner's lines to the Association Water System. This procedure is mandatory in order that the Association maintain control and responsibility for the Quality, Quantity, and Safety of the water system. The Water System Manager shall exercise discretionary powers over the Association Water System!
3. The costs of the operation, maintenance, and repair of the common system shall be paid for by the Association Community Service Fees as previously stated. If the homeowner refuses to pay the appropriate service fees, water service will be terminated by the Association after giving 30 days written notice.
4. The Association will continue to explore ways to improve all aspects of the water system for the benefit of its members.
